Junior Experts

Qualifications and skills:

- A University Degree (where a university degree has been awarded on completion of three years of study in a university or equivalent institution) in social sciences; political sciences; journalism; public relations; languages etc. or at least 5 years of professional experience in addition to General Professional Experience
- Proficiency in written and spoken English
- Have excellent oral and written communication and analytical skills
- Have excellent team working abilities
- Knowledge of Serbian language (or other local languages- Bosnian, Croatian, Montenegrin) will be considered as an advantage

General Professional Experience:

• At least five (5) years, preferable seven (7) of proven professional experience in visibility, awareness raising, and / or public relations.

Specific Professional Experience:

- Minimum three (3), preferably five (5) years of experience in one of the following fields:
