1.	<p>Please find below another question concerning tender "EuropeAid/139025/DH/SER/RS - Development of system for management of Cohesion Policy Location --Republic of Serbia".</p> <p>According to point 16, "Subcontracting is allowed up to the maximum of 15% of the contract value."</p> <p>- Can you clarify if freelance experts (natural person) are considered as subcontractors?</p> <p>- Which documents we need to provide for subcontractors at this stage of the procedure?</p>	<p>Please note that in line with the Instructions to Tenderers (point 3h), which will be part of the Tender Dossier, <i>"even if subcontracting is allowed, the short-listed candidate must intend to provide the majority of the services itself except for the tasks entrusted to experts either as natural persons or single-member companies"</i>.</p> <p>The budget break-down for offers will include the budget line for Fees, broken down into Key experts and Non Key experts.</p> <p>Please refer to Article 4 of the General Conditions to service contracts for more details on subcontracting.</p> <p>At this stage of the procedure, no documents need to be provided for the subcontractors.</p>
