1.	 We would need to know the following: 1. Can a lead applicant on one project proposal be in the role of co-applicant on another project proposal? 2. Can an organization be a lead applicant on more than one project proposal? 3. Can an organization be a co-applicant on two or more project proposals and how many? 4. Is there a limit to a number of co-applicants on one project proposal? 	Answer to point No. 4 is that there is no limit on the number co-applicants per application.The only limitation referred to in the Guidelines is linked to the number of applications a lead applicant or a co-applicant can be a part of as shared below:Number of applications and grants per applicants / affiliated entities (page 13, Guidelines for Applicants)The lead applicant may not submit more than 1 application per lot under this call for proposals.The lead applicant may not be awarded more than 1 grant per lot under this call for proposals.The lead applicant may not be a co-applicant or an affiliated entity in another application of the same lot at the same time.A co-applicant/affiliated entity may not be the co-applicant or affiliated entity in more than 1 application per lot under this call for proposals.A co-applicant/affiliated entity may not be the co-applicant or affiliated entity in more than 1 application per lot under this call for proposals.A co-applicant/affiliated entity may not be awarded more than 1 grant per lot under this call for proposals.In line with the above and directly related to your questions:Answer to point No. 1: The lead applicant may not be a co-applicant or an affiliated entity in another application of the same lot at the same time.
