6. Nature of contract

7. Contract description

The overall objective of the project is to establish a stable and transparent regulatory regime in Serbia in accordance with the national legal framework and the relevant EC Directives.

The purpose of this project is to provide further technical assistance to the AERS to build and develop the capacity of the Agency (building on earlier capacity building TA).

The Consultant is expected to achieve:

• Implementation of the requirements of the Road Maps/ Action Plans for the Energy Community Treaty

• Improved market monitoring and enhanced price/ tariff regulation giving proper incentives to improve efficiency of the utilities

• Increased professional capacity of AERS staff and trained staff.

The Consultant must have expertise in:

- Development of gas and/or electricity markets,
- The field of regulatory accounting
- The design, implementation, and/ or operation of electricity markets
- Design, implementation, and/or operation of gas markets.

8. Number and titles of lots

One lot.

9. Maximum budget

€1,500,000.00

10. Scope for additional services

The Contracting Authority may, at its own discretion, extend the project in duration and/or scope subject to the availability of funding, up to a maximum not exceeding the length and value of the initial contract. Any extension of the contract would be subject to satisfactory performance by the Contractor.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

11. Eligibility

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of candidates which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see also item 30 below). Participation is also open to international organisations. The participation of natural persons is governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

12. Candidature

All eligible natural and legal persons (as per item 11 above) or groupings of such persons (consortia) may apply.

A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (ie, the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the Contracting Authority.

The participation of an ineligible natural or legal person (as per item 11) will result in the automatic exclusion of that person. In particular, if that ineligible person belongs to a consortium, the whole consortium will be excluded.

13. Number of applications

No more than one application can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting an application). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.

14. Shortlist alliances prohibited

Any tenders received from tenderers comprising firms other than those mentioned in the short-listed application forms will be excluded from this restricted tender procedure. Short-listed candidates may not form alliances or subcontract to each other for the contract in question.

15. Grounds for exclusion

As part of the application form, candidates must submit a signed declaration, included in the standard application form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3 of the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EC external actions

16. Sub-contracting

Sub-contracting is not allowed

17. Number of candidates to be short-listed

On the basis of the applications received, between 4-8 candidates will be invited to submit detailed tenders for this contract. If the number of eligible candidates meeting the selection criteria is less than the minimum of 4, the Contracting Authority may invite the candidates who satisfy the criteria to submit a tender.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

21. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

1) Economic and financial capacity of candidate (based on item 3 of the application form)

(a) the average annual turnover of the candidate for the last two years (2006 and 2007) must exceed 750,000 Euro; and

(b) the averages of cash and cash equivalents at the beginning and end of year are positive.

2) Professional capacity of candidate (based on items 4 and 5 of the application form)

(a) at least 8 permanent staff working for the candidates currently work in fields related to this contract; and

3) Technical capacity of candidate (based on items 5 and 6 of the application form)

(a) The candidate has completed at least two projects (where the candidate's proportion is greater than 400,000 Euro for services in each project) in any of the fields of expertise set out in Article 7 within the 5 year period prior to the closing date for submission of applications or has commenced such projects no later than 2007.

If more than 8 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates must be reexamined to identify the eight best applications for the tender procedure. The only factor which will be taken into consideration during this re-examination is the number of projects eligible under the above-mentioned criteria 3 (a). If two or more candidates reach the same number of projects the candidates with a higher total value will prevail.
