1.	<p>Since neither from the heading 8 of the official WORKS PROCUREMENT NOTICE, nor from the Article 19 of the COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) No 1085/2006 of 17 July 2006 establishing an Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) it is not clear whether a company from the Russian Federation can participate, we would very much welcome your urgent official legal clarification of the issue. We address you with this question in accordance with the heading 18 of the official WORKS PROCUREMENT NOTICE, hoping that an urgent answer from your side would be in the spirit of the transparency and legality of the whole procedure and in favor of equality of our company as one of the tenderers.</p>	<p>Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorized by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (IPA).</p> <p>Please be aware that following the eligibility rules of the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (Council Regulation (EC) N° 1085/2006 - OJ L 210/82 of 31.7.2006), legal persons/companies established in a country that is a beneficiary of the European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument:</p> <p>Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Egypt, Georgia, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Moldova, Morocco, Palestinian Authority of the West Bank and Gaza Strip, Russian Federation, Syria, Tunisia, Ukraine are eligible.</p>
