6. Description of the contract

This supply contract includes office equipment, office furniture, server including software and hardware to support the undergoing EU wine twinning project. This contract for supplies belongs to the IPA programme of Capacity Building and Technical Support for the Renewal of Viticulture Zoning and Control of Production of Wine with Designation of Origin. It should complement the existing installations of the Ministry of Agriculture trade Forest and Water management (MATFWM) and strengthen the work of Technical Assistance team within the wine department of the ministry

7. Number and titles of lots

Only one lot consisting of: OFFICE EQUIPMENT, OFFICE FURNITURE, SOFTWARE WITH SERVER, HARDWARE

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 22 below). All goods supplied under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Supply Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the Practical Guide to contracts procedures for EU external actions.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers must submit offers for all lots. Tenders for parts of this lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the supplies required in the tender dossier.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

- 1) Economic and financial capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. item 3 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract). In case of tenderer being a public body, equivalent information should be provided.
 - (a) The average annual turnover of the tenderer for 2008, 2009 and 2010 must be equal to or exceed EUR 100,000.00.
- 2) Professional capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 4 and 5 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
 - (a) At least 3 members of the candidate's permanent staff currently work in fields related to this contract.
- 3) Technical capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 5 and 6 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
 - (a) The tenderer must have carried out in the past three years (starting 01/01/2008), at least two (2) contracts/projects in fields related to this contract (final acceptance certificate has been issued or equivalent¹), the tenderer's proportion of the contract/project is equal to or more than EUR 100,000.00.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator.
