It is requested that "the successful tenderer must submit the warranty certificates for each item to the Contracting authority stating the commencement date as the date of the Provisional Acceptance"</p> <p>Will the offer be valid if we present a statement covering the starting date of Warranty, as the Warranty Certificate itself can be provided only at the moment of provisional acceptance as we cannot predict the exact date of delivery?</p>	<p>Your offer must confirm that it fully accepts and complies with the terms of the contractual warranty as specified and provide an advance copy of the warranty certificate showing that these terms are fully respected. The commencement date must be stated as the date of provisional acceptance. There is thus no need to indicate a date as indeed this not known.</p>
	<p>2.1.3 It is stated "Boot capacity with rear seats up: min 300 liters" Please clarify what do you exactly mean as "rear seats up" – folded (so that you have only front seats for passengers and the rear area is used as luggage area) or unfolded (so that you have regular five seats for passengers) If offered vehicle has 270 liters boot capacity with unfolded seats, would the offer be valid (accepted)?</p>	<p>No - 300 l is min. required with rear seats up (so that you have regular five seats for passengers)</p>

	<p>2.1.11 It is stated "Seats: 5 robust, dirt repellent and flame resistant fabric for seat upholstery"</p> <p>Please clarify if the above mentioned specification is requested for seats themselves or for additional seat covers</p>	<p>The fabric of the regular seat cover should be of flame <u>retarding</u> and dirt repelling material</p>
	<p>2.1.18 It is requested "fire extinguishers" Please specify how many of them</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Minimum one</p>
	<p>2.1.19 It is requested "mechanical immobiliser" Please clarify what do you mean under mechanical immobilizer, as there are two different types - permanently and temporary fixed mechanical devices</p>	<p>Mechanical immobilizer refers to any passenger cabin based device that when locked blocks effectively gear lever or steering wheel or prevents in any other mechanical way from within the passenger compartment unauthorized removal of the vehicle. The device must be permanently fixed and provide security above and beyond the standard steering lock. Purely mobile mechanical immobilizers are not acceptable.</p>
	<p>2.1.20 It is requested "2 spare stickers per vehicle" Please clarify if it is additional set of same stickers already described in Annex II and III, item no. 2.1.20 and Special Conditions, Article 29.1, or some other type of stickers</p>	<p>Yes</p>
<p>2.</p>	<p>Lot 1 – item 1.2, article 1.2.1 Concerning Principle of Operation of PM10 analyzer:</p> <p>It is stated in the technical specification of the PM10 analyzer that principle of operation must be Beta Attenuation. As a matter of fact, there are several other principle of operation for PM10 analyzers fully certified according to EN12341 and it would be in contradiction to the public procurement procedures in EU funded projects or equal treatment of tenderers.</p> <p>Please confirm that all EN12341 certified PM10 analyzers can be offered in this tender</p>	<p>Any PM 10 analyzer certified according to EN 12341 with a test equivalence report and employing a <u>continuous measurement</u> method is acceptable</p>
