1.	<ul> <li>About the Tender guarantee, page 18, 15.2 of the "Instructions to Tender" we would like to know if it is possible to submit a tender guarantee provided by an Insurance Company due to we have just informed that in Serbia there is not possible to emit thin kind of guarantees from an Insurance Company.</li> <li>About the same issue we would like to know if it is possible to submit 2 tender guarantees in the same tender, each one from each partner of the Joint Venture.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>In line with Instruction to tenders Section 15. Tender guarantee, Sub-section 15.2:         <ul> <li>'It may be provided in the form of a bank guarantee, a banker's draft, a certified cheque, a guarantee provided by an insurance and/or guarantee company or an irrevocable letter of credit made out to the Contracting Authority.'</li> </ul> </li> <li>In line with Works Contract Notice, item 11, and Instructions to Tenderers, section 15, the tender guarantee must be in the amount of 60,000 Euro when submitting a tender. This implies that only one tender guarantee per offer may be submitted.</li> </ul>
2.	Please give approval to draft tender guarantees attached, because we are on the tender for the Construction of access roads Zezelj bridge in Novi Sad participate as partners with a share of 20%, and this amount should give a guarantee, while partners will provide the rest.	In line with the applicable Practical Guide, section 5.3.4, "the contracting authority cannot give a prior opinion on the assessment of the tender".
