The 2022 Census of Population, Households and Dwellings, conducted in October 2022, provided a large amount of data on the spatial distribution and basic characteristics of all census units.

Special attention was given to data dissemination in accordance with user needs. For this purpose, 13 census books were published (eight books containing data on population, households, and families, and five books with data on dwellings and buildings), around 50 tables in the dissemination database, and more than 60 tables in Excel format.

Additionally, four special publications were released: "Most common names and surnames in the Republic of Serbia," "Population projections of the Republic of Serbia 2022–2052", "Complete life tables for the Republic of Serbia 2021-2023" and "Census for the beginners".

Additionally, in cooperation with academic professors and scientific researchers, 12 thematic studies based on the 2022 Census results were prepared, achieving a synergy between statistics and science while adding a new dimension to the census data.
