And are there any other limitation that we cannot be a partner on this call. As deadline for closing this call is very soon, please can you give us an answer quickly.	Please refer to Contract Notice, Article 11 Eligibility, first paragraph:  11. Eligibility  Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping — consortium — of tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) N° 236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable Instrument under which the contract is financed (see also heading 29 below). Participation is also open to international organisations.  Please also bear in mind section 2.3.3.2 of the PRAG which states:  The contracting authority shall not award a contract for a given procurement procedure to an economic operator who:  a) is in one of the exclusion situations under section 2.3.3.1;  b) has misrepresented the information required by the contracting authority as a condition for participating in the procedure or has failed to supply that information;  c) was previously involved in the preparation of procurement documents where this entails a distortion of competition that cannot be remedied otherwise;
