1.1 DESCRIPTION OF THE ASSIGNMENT – Senior non key expert on assessment the progress in the Education sector reform related to efficiency and policy financing

Project background

The project has as main objective to assist the Government of Serbia in implementing reforms in the education sector by improving the quality, equity and relevance of the education and training. Actually the project provides assessment of the compliance of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology Development (MoESTD) with the General and Specific Conditions for the release of fixed and variable tranches as set out in the Annex I.a of the Financing Agreement for the "Sector Reform Contract for Education Reform in Serbia strengthening links with employment and social inclusion" and to provide recommendations to the EU Delegation to the Republic of Serbia on the achievement of the indicators for the fixed and variable tranches and the value of the tranches to be disbursed. The main results that have to be achieved are 1) ensuring the capability of EUD to determine the extent of progress achieved in the implementation of education reforms, and in particular in the context of SRC contract performance and 2) ensuring the capability of EUD to conduct an informed policy dialogue under the SRC, in particular on issues related to Roma inclusion and education in minority languages; 3) assessment of the financial support provided to Republic of Serbia from IPA I and IPA II in the field of education and promotion of this support.

Objectives of the assignment

The assignment will primarily contribute to the achievement of the first project result. The main expected outcome of this assignment is elaboration of an assessment report on the progress made in the implementation of the Action Plan to the Education Strategy in the year 2019 related to efficiency of the education reform measures and the policy financing covering all education areas as pre-school, primary, secondary, higher education, continuous professional development and adult education and Roma and minorities inclusion.The assessment will also cover the main developments in the policy dialogue in the education sector including measures for strengthening the education reform and budget processes to deliver the relevant policy.

Main Tasks

- 1. Participate in the process of data collection (take part in interviews and focus groups, support elaboration of questionnaires);
- 2. Review of all available documents and collected data related to the progress made in the pre-school, primary, secondary, higher education, continuous professional development and adult education and Roma and minorities inclusion areas of the Education reform regarding their efficiency;
- 3. Review the particular elements consisting the funding formulas of different levels of education;
- 4. Review of the spent and available financing for the education reform;
- 5. Review of the processes used in the preparation of the annual state budget in view of its allocation to the needs of education reform;
- 6. Review the monitoring system in spending for education needs through the state budget allocations (quarterly);
- 7. Review of all available documents and collected data related to the main developments of the policy dialogue in the eduaction sector in year 2019;
